Call Summary

December 2010

- 12/2/10 Personnel responded to a report of smoke inside a residence on 27th Avenue. Upon arrival, personnel entered the building and found a light haze of smoke. A quick investigation showed the origin of the smoke was the structure's HVAC unit. Power was secured to the unit and the owner was advised to leave the unit out of service until repairs can be completed.
- 12/18/10 Personnel responded to a possible electrical fire inside a residence on Charleston Boulevard. Upon arrival crews found no signs of smoke or fire visible and met with the resident. Resident said they unplugged an appliance and the electrical outlet caught fire. Personnel found the exterior of the outlet darkened, but not burning. The outlet was removed from the wall, the wires taped, and power secured to the residence. A thorough check of the building was completed to ensure no fire extension into the walls around the outlet.
