### Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary June 2010

6/1/10	Personnel responded to a report of a woman locked out on a balcony at Sea Cabins. Firefighters used a ladder to get the woman down safely.
6/2/10	Personnel responded to the beach at Station 25, where Sullivan's Island personnel were working on a person in full arrest as a result of a near drowning. The other two (2) swimmers were put on Boat 5 and returned to the beach. Boat 5 was trailered and returned to Station 1.
6/6/10	Personnel responded to a call of a sailboat with people possibly in distress. Caller was on the beach and advised she wasn't sure if there was distress but vessel seemed to have been stuck on a sandbar. Boat 6 was launched and made contact with the vessel's crew who advised they had gotten stuck but were able to break free and no time were any persons in distress.
6/8/10	Personnel responded with Boat 3 to Goat Island to investigate a resident's problem with the stove. Fire Department personnel secured power to the stove at the breaker and using the Thermal Imager was able to determine that there was an increase in temperature to the breakers around the stove. Smoke detectors were checked and a new detector was installed. The owner was advised to call 911 if there were any additional problems. Boat 3 returned to the Isle of Palms Marina.
6/17/10	Personnel responded to Summerhouse Villas for three (3) people stuck in the elevator on the 4 <sup>th</sup> floor. Elevator keys were used to open the door. Residents were uninjured and did not require any medical assistance.
6/17/10	Personnel arrived on 55 <sup>th</sup> Avenue to be met by a resident's son who advised that his mother was stuck in the elevator for about an hour due to a power failure. The resident stated that she was okay, however, the owner was unable to provide elevator keys. Engine 2's keys did not work and hinges on door were rusted. Door was popped with minimal damage since resident did not want to wait for power to be restored.
6/18/10	Personnel responded to a call of a reported fire in an outside grill on the back deck of the VFW. Upon arrival found two (2) grills with propane being piped in from underground tank. One grill was glowing red and the control knobs had melted off and the other was at a normal cooking temperature. Key holder and Police Department arrived and the main propane tank was secured by the building manager and firefighters returned to station.

### Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary June 2010

6/21/10	Personnel launched Boat 3 to respond to call of a boat stranded on an oyster bed in Grey Bay. Engine 1 responded to connector for visual of the stranded boat. Boat 3 was forced to turn around since the tide was too low. Command requested Charleston County Air Boat and it was launched from the marina. Engine 1 was relocated to the marina and Rescue 2 went to the connector for the visual. Upon Charleston County's arrival at the stranded vessel, the people decided to stay on the boat until the tide came in. Occupants were advised to call the Coast Guard when freed from the oyster bed. All units returned to the station.
6/28/10	Personnel responded to Cameron Boulevard for a downed power line. The power pole had broken and residents were advised to stay in their homes and no people were allowed to enter the street until safe. SCE&G killed the power to the lines and allowed some residents to return home. Residents were advised that the crews would be arriving to repair the lines
6/29/10	Personnel responded a swimmer far out in the ocean. Additional calls were received and the Captain was advised that a friend paddled out on a surf board to try and get him. Boat 5 was launched and was able to pick up the swimmer from the surfer and return him to shore. The swimmer was checked and released.
6/29/10	Isle of Palms Fire Department personnel responded to several calls for missing children on the beach. All the missing children were found and reunited with the appropriate people.
6/29/10	Isle of Palms Fire Department personnel warned numerous visitors about sandbar dangers.

### Communications Report June 2010

June 9, 2010

Representatives from Charleston County, Motorola, and Crown Castle addressed the Public Safety Committee and discussed the radio tower that has been proposed for installation on the Isle of Palms. The proposed tower is one of six needed to improve public safety communications in some locations to an acceptable level throughout Charleston County. There are three phases to the overall radio system upgrade project. The Isle of Palms towers along with five other towers are part of Phase 1 and Phase II. The current proposal is to construct a 230' communications tower near the water tower located at 1300 Palm Boulevard. The Public Safety Committee requested that Motorola, Charleston County, and Crown Castle investigate alternative locations on and off of the island.

### June 11, 2010

Chief Graham met with representatives of the Isle of Palms Water Commission, Charleston County, and Crown Castle to discuss the proposed radio communications tower on Isle of Palms. After an onsite visit, it was determined that a 230' monopole type tower could be constructed within the space available next to the water tower which would allow for an easy transfer of existing equipment from the water tower to the new tower. The group also discussed several additional locations that will be evaluated.


