Date: March 4, 2011

The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of February 2011.

Patrol

February 2, 2011 Just after 5 P.M., officers responded to a JC Long Boulevard establishment where management reported a loud, belligerent, and intoxicated female patron. When an officer arrived, the intoxicated patron was attempting to enter a vehicle in the parking lot to leave the area. A taxi was called, but before it arrived, the patron again began to be loud and profane, which resulted in her arrest for Disorderly Conduct.

February 3, 2011 Officers responded to a high rise condominium in Wild Dunes regarding an elderly female suffering from Alzheimer's on a balcony shouting incoherently to her daughter in the parking lot. The daughter was unable to make entry to the unit and requested that forced entry be made to make contact. Entry was made by Police and Fire Department personnel. EMS was summoned and transported the subject to MUSC for evaluation.

February 4, 2011 An officer responded to a residence on 24th Avenue to speak with a male subject who wished to report that his former girlfriend showed up in his residence, unannounced and uninvited, but she left prior to the officer's arrival. The resident did not wish to press charges, but wanted the incident documented. The officer made telephone contact with the female subject and advised her accordingly.

February 5, 2011 It was reported that two dogs jumped from the rear bed of a pickup truck near Breach Inlet and the truck continued down Palm Boulevard apparently unaware. An officer stopped the vehicle on Palm Boulevard near 14th Avenue and while speaking to the driver discovered that he was in possession of an open container of beer. He was charged with Open Container. The dogs were last seen on Sullivan's Island.

February 6, 2011 An officer on patrol stopped a vehicle on the Connector for operating erratically and while speaking to the female driver determined that she was disoriented and speaking incoherently. After some conversation it was determined that the driver needed medical attention. Fire Department First Responders were summoned and determined that she needed further medical attention. EMS arrived and transported the subject to a local hospital for evaluation.

February 12, 2011 An officer on patrol was forced to take evasive action to avoid being struck by a vehicle approaching from the opposite direction that was partially in the officers lane of traffic. The officer turned around and followed the vehicle and stopped it in a safe place on Palm Boulevard near 9th Avenue. The officer immediately noted that it was 35 degrees out and the driver had lowered all of the windows to the vehicle. The officer immediately detected an odor of alcohol and asked the driver for paperwork several times which the driver had trouble providing what was requested. The driver attempted to perform several Field Sobriety Tests and performed poorly. The driver was transported to the Public Safety Building and administered a Datamaster Test, where she refused to provide a sample and was charged with DUI and taken to the Detention Center.

February 14, 2011 An officer responded to the parking lot of a Palm Boulevard business, where a merchant reported a possible intoxicated female subject on the property. The officer located the subject lying on the ground within five feet of the street. The subject spoke incoherently and was unable to provide any personal information. The subject then attempted to walk away from the officer and was taken into custody and charged with Disorderly Conduct. She was found to be in possession of a water bottle filled with white wine, which was photographed and destroyed.

February 16, 2011 An officer on patrol of the Connector stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation and while speaking to the officer the driver was unable to produce the registration. The officer observed an open container of beer while speaking to the driver, which was removed and poured out. Once the driver exited the vehicle, a quantity of marijuana was located in the console and drivers area, consisting of three small plastic bags. The driver was charged with Open Container, Simple Possession of Marijuana, and Operating an Uninsured Motor Vehicle and was transported to the Detention Center.

February 19, 2011 A City employee observed a visibly intoxicated female attempting to find her vehicle using her remote keyless entry device. An officer located the subject and confirmed that she was intoxicated and arranged for a taxi to pick her up. Before the taxi arrived, the subject

became combative and due to the fact that she was unable to care for herself, was taken into custody and charged with Disorderly Conduct.

February 20, 2011 Just after midnight, an officer on patrol stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation near Breach Inlet. While speaking to the occupants the officer detected an odor of alcohol and made the determination that the two occupants were only seventeen years old. The occupants were found to be in possession of false identification as well as open containers of beer. They were charged with Lend Borrow Another's DL and Possession/Consumption of Alcohol Under 21.

February 20, 2011 Just before midnight, officers responded to the base of the Connector at the intersection of Palm Boulevard to a three vehicle accident. The investigating officer determined that a vehicle ran into the rear of two vehicles waiting to turn onto Palm Boulevard from the Connector. The officer made immediate contact with the driver of the vehicle at fault and observed him to have a knot on his forehead and a very strong odor of alcohol about his person. Neither driver of the other two other vehicles were injured and both of their vehicles were able to be driven away. The driver at fault stated that he had been at a beer drinking party in Mount Pleasant. Due to the injury to his head he was transported by EMS top a local hospital where he was treated and released. Once released, he was transported back to the Isle of Palms Public Safety Building, where he was administered a Datamaster Test, which registered a .18% level of alcohol. The subject was charged with DUI and transported to the Detention Center.

February 22, 2011 An officer on patrol discovered a large tree downed across the roadway on 19th Avenue and Myrtle Boulevard. The Fire Department was notified and the roadway was cleared to allow vehicular traffic to pass.

February 23, 2011 Officers responded to a disturbance at a Palm Boulevard residence. Upon the officers arrival they separated all parties and determined that a resident had a verbal misunderstanding with a washing machine repairman, which resulted with the repairman being assaulted by the sixteen year old daughter of the homeowner, and escalated into mutual combat involving three persons. The repairman and the juvenile were charged with Assault & Battery 3rd Degree, since it could not be confirmed who the primary aggressor was.

February 25, 2011 An officer on patrol stopped a vehicle on Palm Boulevard near 8th Avenue for an equipment violation and made the determination that the license plate was suspended for no insurance. It was also determined that the driver's license was suspended. He was charged with DUS 1st, No Proof of Insurance and given a warning for the equipment violation.

February 25, 2011 A Sullivan's Island Police Officer had a subject in custody suspected of DUI and requested that one of our certified Datamaster Operator's provide a Datamaster Test for his suspect at the Isle of Palms Public Safety Building. The test was administered and the subject registered a .25% level of alcohol.

February 26, 2011 An officer on patrol stopped a vehicle on Waterway Boulevard near 32nd Avenue for speeding and a computer check indicated that the driver's license was suspended. He was charged with Speeding, DUS 1st, Failure to Surrender Suspended License Plate, and No Proof of Insurance.

February 26, 2011 An officer traveling inbound on the Connector stopped a vehicle several cars in front of him for careless operation. While speaking to the driver the officer observed several burnt marijuana cigarettes in the floor of the vehicle. The driver was taken into custody and a wooden box was located in the vehicle containing a scale and more than 200 baggies with marijuana residue, as well as a full baggie of marijuana. The driver was charged with Improper Lane Usage and Simple Possession of Marijuana.

Personnel/Community Relations

February 17, 2011 Detective Sgt. Caldwell and TCO Burton received a complimentary letter from a citizen regarding their professionalism in dealing with an incident that he had reported to the Police Department.

February 19, 2011 A citizen visiting the Isle of Palms sent Chief Buckhannon a letter of appreciation regarding his family's recent contact with PFC Baldrick.

February 19, 2011 Chief Buckhannon, Sgt. Caldwell, Sgt. Ambas, and Det. Tarr attended the Annual Wild Dunes Association Meeting at Sweetgrass Pavilion. Presentations were given regarding Crime Prevention to almost 300 residents.

February 26, 2011 The Police Department held their annual Doggie Day at the Recreation Center, where more than forty dogs were registered and received Rabies shots.

February 28, 2011 For the month of February, officers discovered five businesses and four homes with open or unsecured doors. A total of ninety-six Victim of Crime Forms or Property Security Check Forms were issued to business or homeowners for various violations noted, or to advise that an officer checked their property during the night while on patrol.
