**Call Summary**  
*June 2018*

- 6/1/18 Fire crews responded to a motor vehicle accident on Palm Boulevard near the Breach Inlet Bridge. A golf cart was being towed by a pick-up truck to Sullivan's Island. While being towed, the brakes on the golf cart locked-up causing the golf cart to flip with two individuals on board. Fire Department personnel arrived on scene with Charleston County EMS and assisted with patient care for one individual with injuries. All personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 6/15/18 Fire crews responded to an automobile versus bicycle accident at 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue and Charleston Boulevard. Upon arrival crews found one individual who had been struck by a pick-up truck in the intersection. The patient was treated accordingly due to his mechanism of injury and transported by Charleston County EMS. All personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 6/22/18 Fire crews responded to an outside fire that was threatening a structure on Palmetto Drive. Upon arrival crews found a pine straw fire around a designated picnic area approximately 20 foot by 30 foot and approximately 15 foot from the Wild Dunes Property Owners Beach House. Fire crews quickly extinguished the fire and performed an overhaul of the area to make sure that no further "hot spots" remained. All personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 6/24/18 Fire crews responded to a structure fire at Ship Watch on Palmetto Drive. Upon arrival, Fire Department personnel found a fire in the kitchen of a unit on the 4<sup>th</sup> story of the building resulting from an arc in the microwave. The fire was quickly extinguished and overhauled to ensure that no further threat from fire existed. All adjoining units were also checked for any possible fire extension. All personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.

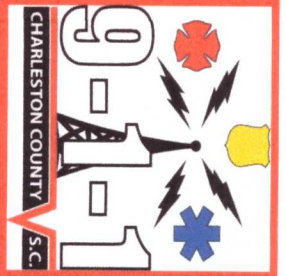

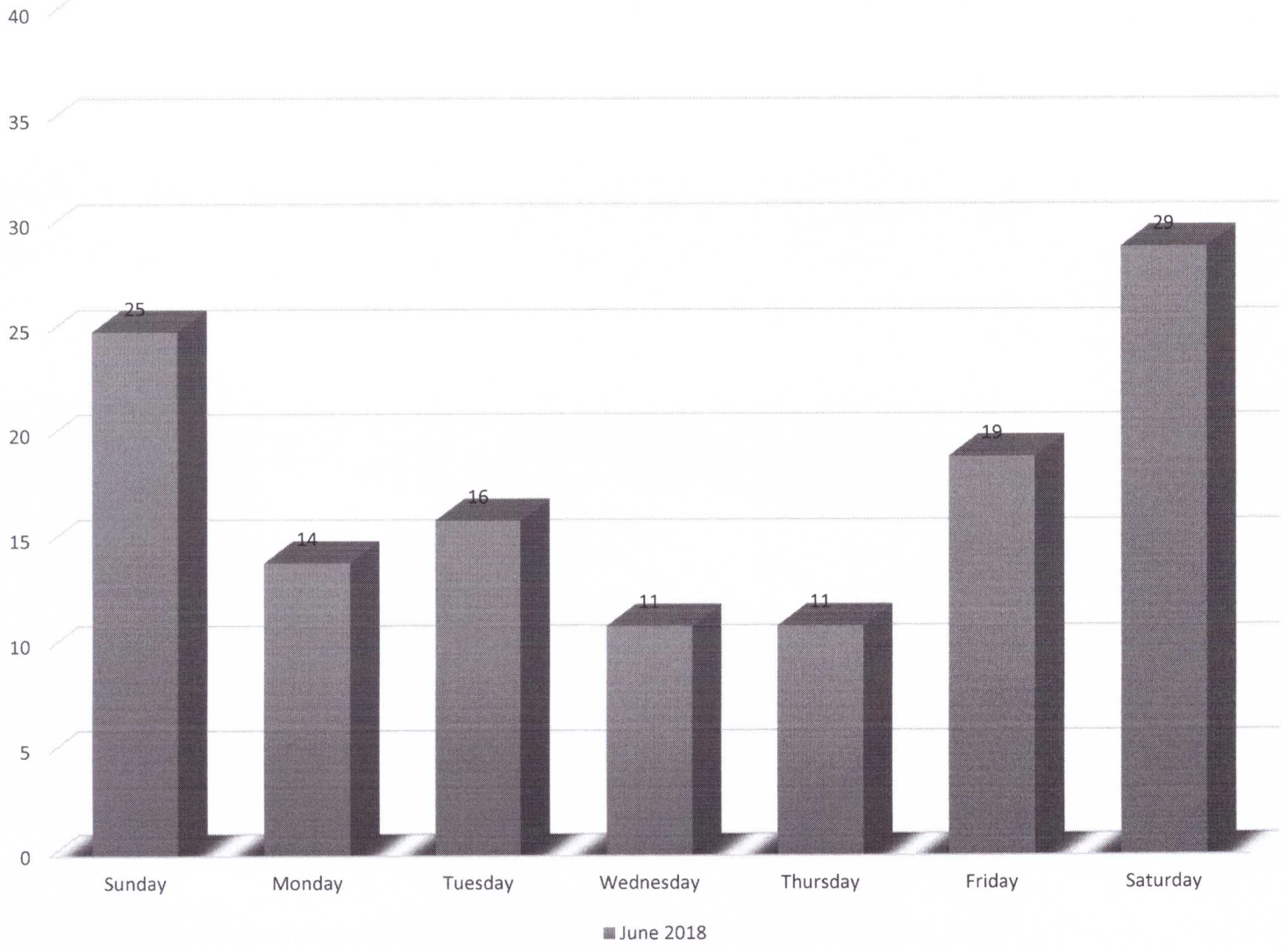

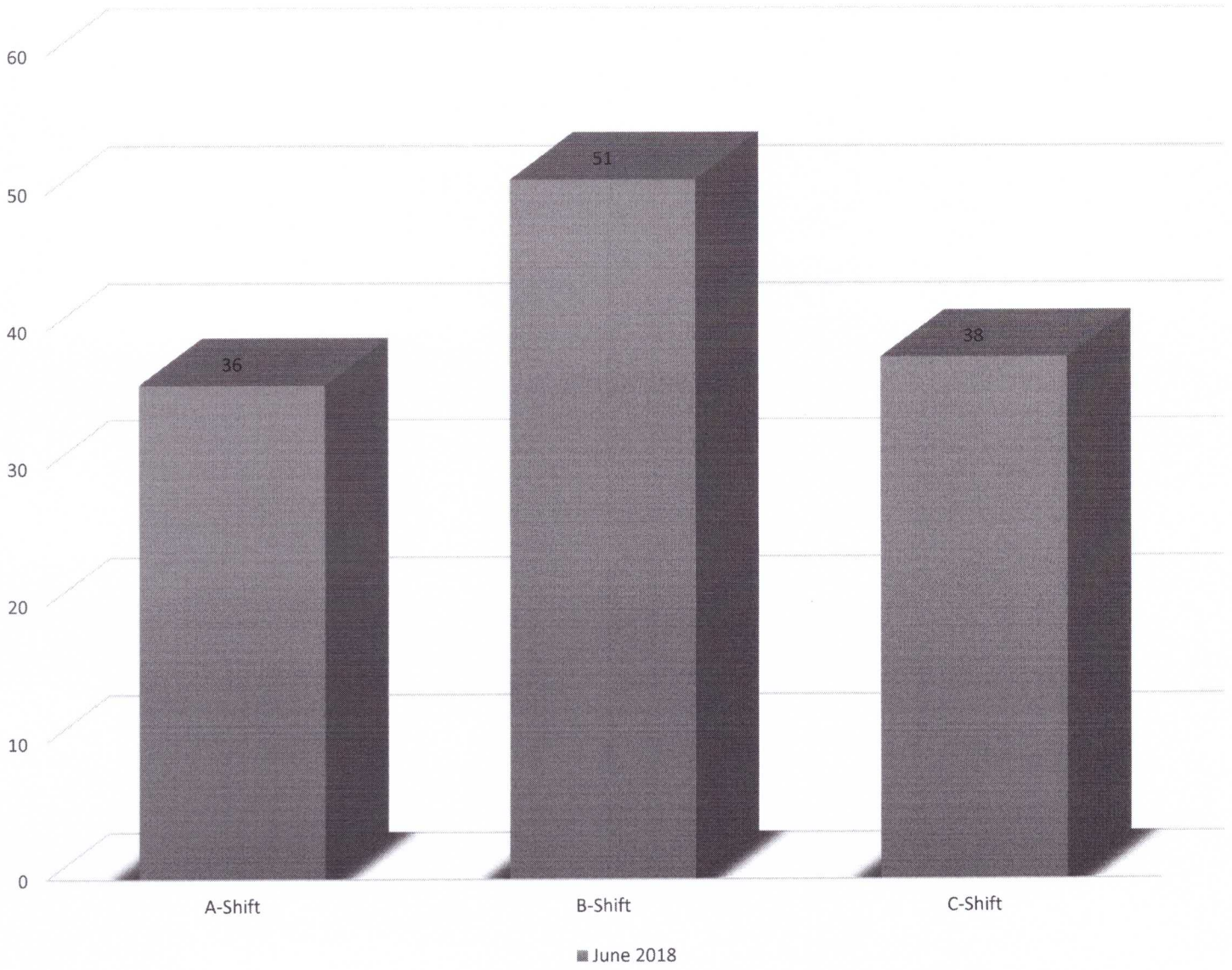


### Calls per Day for June 2018

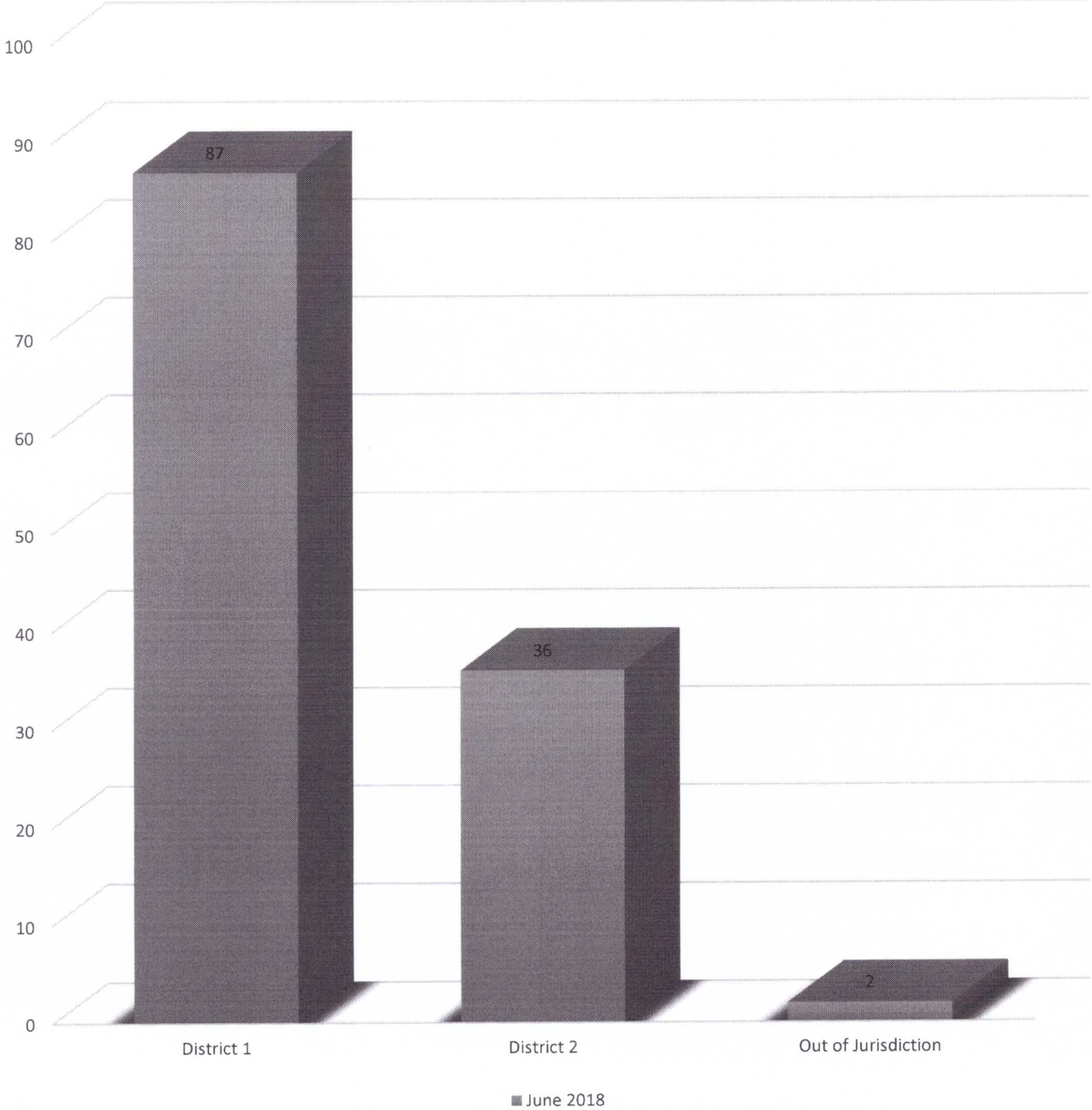




### Calls Per Shift for June 2018
