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## Isle of Palms Fire Department

### Call Summary

October 2018

- 10/4/18 Fire crews responded to a report of an outside fire in the area of 3600 Palm Boulevard. Upon arrival, personnel found a large patch of vegetation burning in the dunes. The fire was not threatening any structures. Firefighters extinguished the fire and watered the area around the location of the fire in order to prevent any further flare ups. It was found that the fire was started by an individual who was trying to "smoke out some bees in the area". After the fire was extinguished, fire crews cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 10/9/18 Fire crews responded to a report of an electrical hazard in the area of the Wild Dunes Gate 1. Upon arrival it was found that a general contractor's vehicle had struck and damaged a power pole. Fire personnel had dispatch contact SCE&G with the necessary information to make repairs to the pole and system. The pole continued to degrade while crews were on scene and the power lines were arcing and causing sparks in the nearby trees. Traffic was blocked on Palm Boulevard from 44<sup>th</sup> Avenue to 47<sup>th</sup> Avenue. SCE&G arrived on scene to make repairs and traffic control was turned over to Isle of Palms Police personnel. Fire crews cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 10/11/18 Fire crews responded to a report of an electrical hazard in the area of Palm Boulevard and 14<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Upon arrival crews found a power pole that had been broken at the base and leaning, being held up by the wires. Isle of Palms Fire and Police personnel established a safety perimeter around the area (which was on Palm Boulevard in front of the Harris Teeter). SCE&G was notified and responded to fix the issue. Once the scene was determined safe, all personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 10/11/18 Fire crews responded to a report of an auto accident in the area of Twin Oaks. Upon arrival, fire personnel found a single vehicle (a white Ford F-150 truck) that had ran over two bushes and struck a tree on Racquet Club next to the swim center. The driver of the vehicle was not found in the area. No hazards were found from the vehicle and Isle of Palms Police personnel were asked to request the fire department to return if the driver was found and needed medical attention. All personnel cleared from the scene and returned back to service.

### Call Summary

October 2018

- 10/24/18 Fire crews responded to Port O' Call on Palmetto Drive for a report of a structure fire. Upon arrival, personnel found smoke coming from the first floor unit of the multi-family structure. There was no response from residents. The front door of the unit was locked and had to be forced open. Fire crews found a pot that had been left on the stove. There was no active burning at that time. The pot was removed, the stove turned off and the area checked for damage caused by heat. The home was naturally ventilated due to the smoke created by the food left on the stove. Isle of Palms Police were made aware of the forced door and that we were unable to secure the residence after we left. All crews cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 10/27/18 Fire crews responded to Dewees Island to assist with a structure fire. Five personnel responded via Boat 1020. Upon arrival, the fire had been extinguished by Dewees Island Fire personnel. Isle of Palms Fire Crews assisted with salvage and overhaul. Once completed, Dewees Island Fire command released all Isle of Palms personnel who cleared from the scene and returned back to service.
- 10/31/18 Fire crews responded to the 500 block of Carolina Boulevard for a report of an outside fire. Upon arrival, fire personnel found a small area of pine straw burning next to a structure. The fire was extinguished. After investigating, it was found that the fire was a result of electrical wiring for an irrigation system that had become exposed and ignited the vegetation. Power was secured to the irrigation system and the homeowner was informed to have it fixed before restoring the power. All crews cleared from the scene and returned back to service.

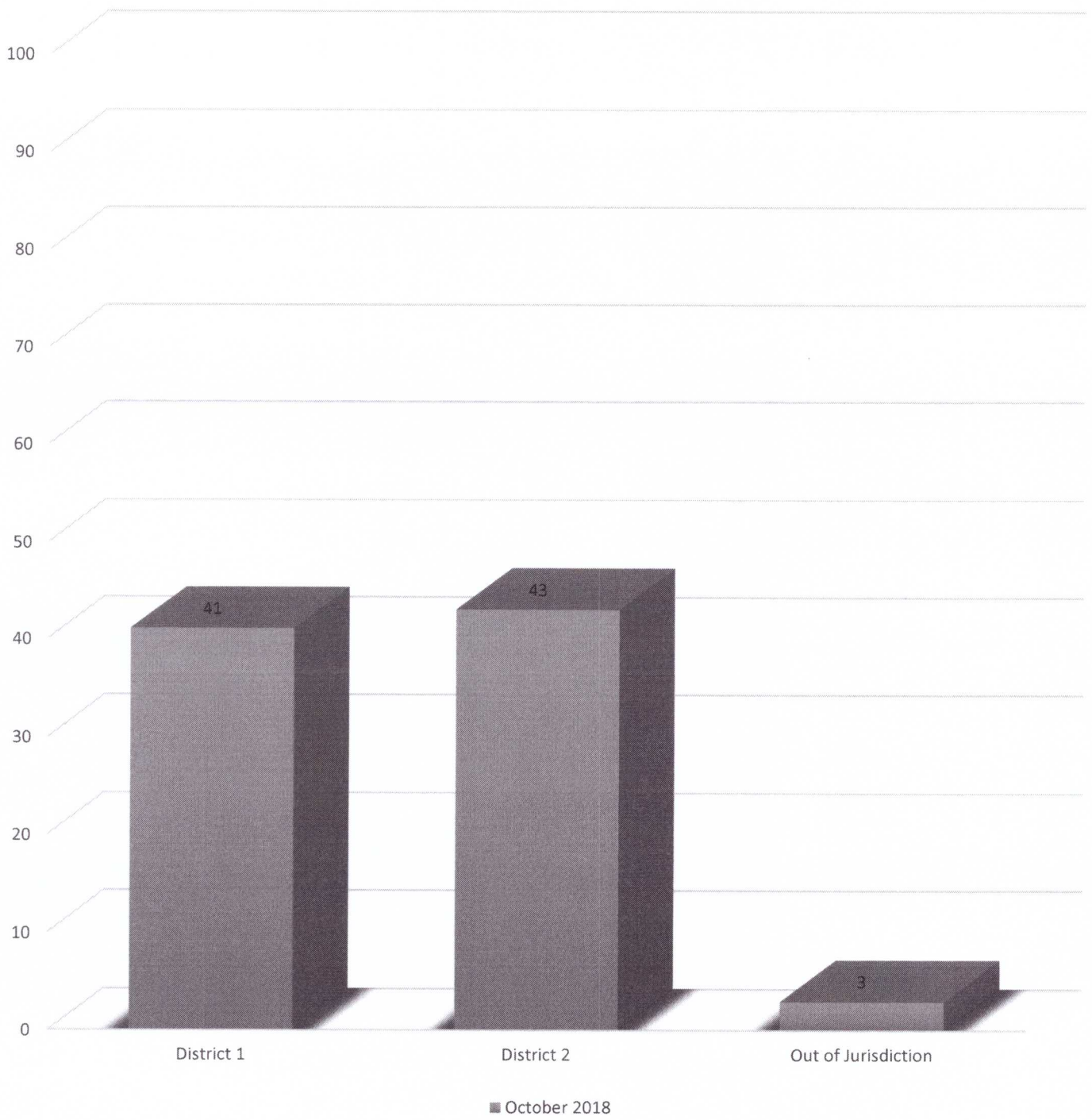
### Calls per Day for October 2018
