Isle of Palms Fire Department Call Summary May 2016

- 5/1/2016 Personnel responded to a report of a person in distress in the ocean near Breach Inlet. Upon arrival the crew established visual contact with a paddle boarder and a jet ski was launched to check on the individual. The paddle boarder told personnel he could not get back on his board, but he was going to swim ashore. The jet ski accompanied the individual until he safely returned to shore. All units returned to service.
- 5/3/2016 Personnel responded to a report of a lightning strike to a building at the Wild Dunes Reception Center. Upon arrival crews were directed to a shed near the tennis courts that had been struck by lightning. Upon investigation personnel found damage to the shed's electrical system. The damage was isolated to the immediate area of the strike and no other damage was found. The power to the shed was secured and South Carolina Electric and Gas was notified. All units returned to service.
- Personnel responded to a report of a structure fire at the Citadel Beach House. Upon arrival crews found heavy fire showing from three sides and initiated an exterior attack to knock down the bulk of the fire. After knocking the fire down, crews entered the building and conducted an interior attack on the remaining fire. Once the fire was brought under control, crews conducted salvage and overhaul operations. The Mount Pleasant and Sullivan's Island fire departments assisted with control and extinguishment of the fire. All units returned to service.
- Personnel responded to a report of a grass fire near a residence on 28th
 Avenue. The fire was extinguished by the resident prior to the arrival of the fire department. The fire started in a pile of dried leaves near the gas grill.

 The area was check to ensure the fire was out and all units returned to service.
- 5/8/2016 Personnel responded to a report of an outside fire at the Citadel Beach House. Upon arrival crews found a small fire burning inside a support column at the corner of the building. Personnel cut a hole in the column and extinguished the fire. All units returned to service.
- 5/22/2016 Personnel responded to a report of a structure fire at the Seaside Inn.

 Upon arrival crews were advised that a visitor had lit a Chinese lantern and it had fallen onto the roof of a nearby building. Personnel laddered the adjoining building to investigate. The crew found the debris from the Chinese lantern, the fire had self-extinguished, and there was no damage or extension of the fire. The debris was removed from the roof and all units returned to service.
