The following is a synopsis of some of the activities of the Isle of Palms Police Department during the month of January.

January 1 – Tuesday

Traffic Offense – Carolina Boulevard / 7th Avenue

An officer stopped a vehicle for an expired vehicle license. Contact with the driver determined that his driver's license was suspended. Further investigation determined that this driver had been previously stopped by our agency on two separate occasions for driving under suspension. It was also determined that the vehicle license plate was expired, and the vehicle was not insured. The driver was arrested and transported to the AI Cannon Detention Center.

January 5 – Saturday

Motor Vehicle Theft – 20th Avenue

A victim reported that unknown persons stole his golf cart that had been parked at his residence. The approximate value of the stolen vehicle is \$1,900. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

January 8 – Tuesday

Driving Under the Influence – IOP Connector

An officer stopped a vehicle for an equipment violation. Contact with the driver determined that she was possibly under the influence. While speaking with the driver, the officer observed a half full bottle of whiskey sitting on the front passenger seat. The officer requested the driver complete Standardized Field Sobriety Tests and upon completion was placed under arrest. The driver was transported to the IOPPSB for Datamaster testing where she provided a breath sample of 0.00% BAC. A Drug Recognition Expert was requested to further evaluate the driver. Upon completion of the DRE evaluation, the driver was charged and transported to the AI Cannon Detention Center.

Traffic Offense – Back Bay Drive / Seagrass Lane

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 35MPH in a posted 25MPH speed zone. Contact with the driver determined that her driver's license was suspended. The driver was issued a citation with a court date in the Isle of Palms Municipal Court.

January 9 – Wednesday

Burglary – 400 Block Carolina Boulevard

A victim report that unknown persons stole jewelry from her residence. The items stolen are a pair of earrings and two bracelets valued at approximately \$8,085. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

January 13 – Sunday

Traffic Offense – IOP Connector

An officer stopped a vehicle for speeding, 105MPH in a posted 55MPH speed zone. Contact with the driver determined that he had an odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. The driver was charged with reckless driving and transported to the Al Cannon Detention Center.

January 14 – Monday

Forgery – 2900 Block Skinner Boulevard

A victim reported that an unknown person removed a check from the back of her checkbook and it had been cashed in the amount of \$2,800. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

January 17 – Thursday

Wire/Computer/Other Electronic Manipulation – 100 Block Oakview Lane

A victim reported that unknown person committed wire fraud by hacking her email. The unknown person emailed the victim requesting a payment of \$3,466 and then responded again asking why the payment had not been made. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

January 18 – Friday

Burglary – 5800 Block Palmetto Drive

A victim reported that while staying in a rental property she secured her jewelry, passport, cash and handgun in the room safe. When she began packing to return home, she found that the only item missing from the safe was the handgun. The approximate value of the stolen firearm is \$600. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

January 20 – Sunday

Burglary – Abalone Alley

A victim reported that unknown persons entered her rental property and stole two televisions. The approximate value of the stolen items is \$954. An open window was located in the residence. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.

January 27 – Sunday

Motor Vehicle Theft – 200 Block Forest Trail

A victim reported that unknown persons stole his 2017 Chevrolet Traverse which had been parked in his driveway. It was determined that the vehicle was unlocked, and the keys had been left inside. The approximate value of the stolen vehicle is \$32,988. This case has been assigned to CID for further investigation.
