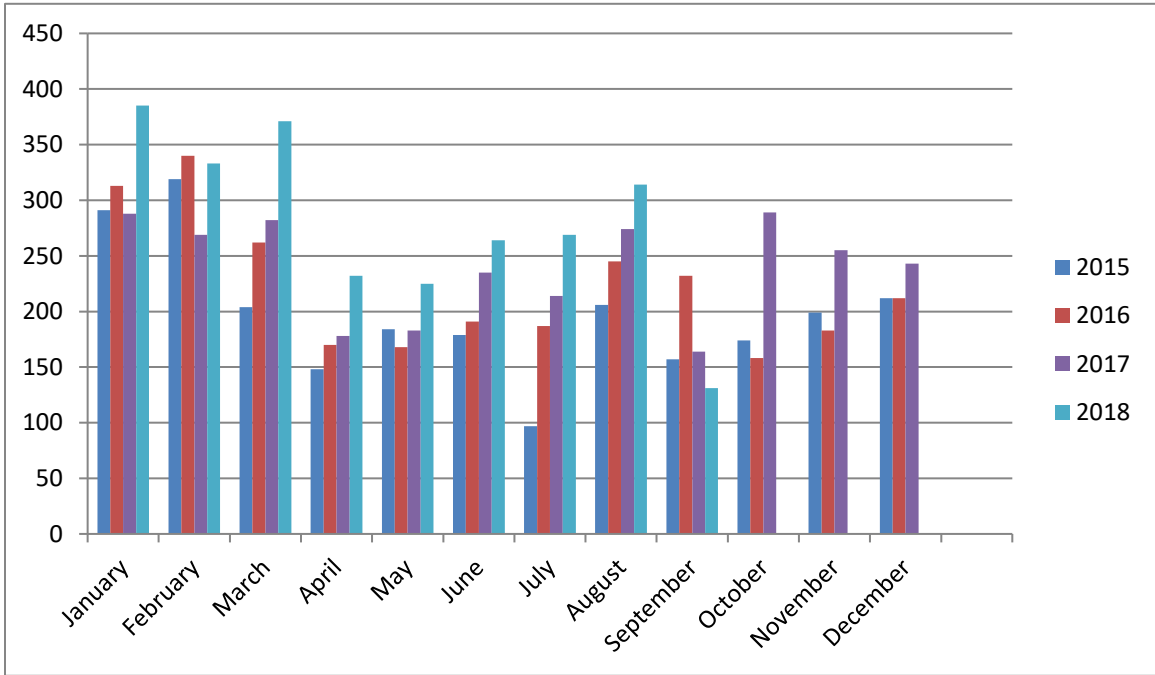
Holiday Street Festival
