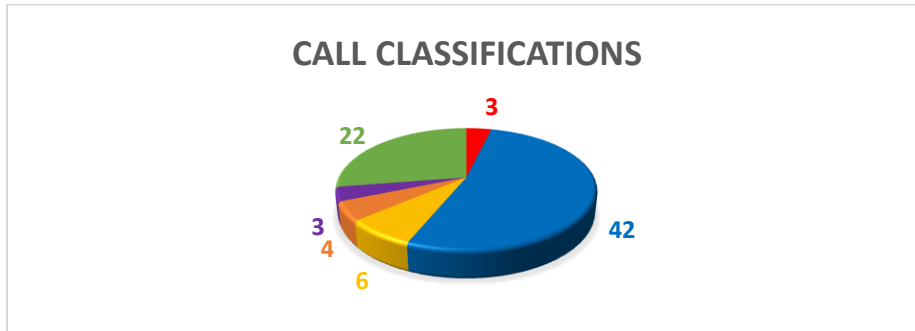


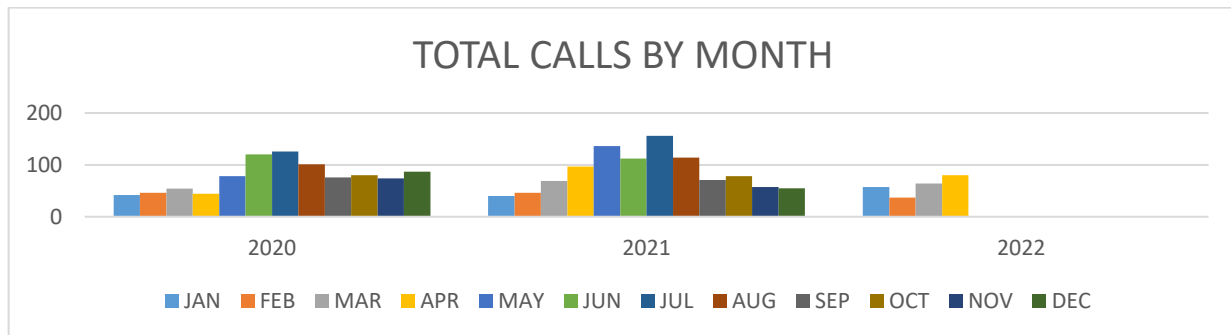

NOTABLE EVENTS / CALL HIGHLIGHTS

- 04/01/2022 Fire crews responded to a motor vehicle versus golf cart accident at Seagrass Lane and Back Bay Drive. There was no damage to either vehicle. One patient was treated for injuries and turned over to Charleston County EMS. All units then cleared from the scene and returned to service.
- 04/05/2022 Fire crews responded to a report of a smell of smoke which was then upgraded to a structure fire on Dolphin Row. Upon arrival firefighters found no sign of flame or smoke but could smell something burning. The homeowner stated that their dishwasher had been tripping its breaker earlier that day. Power was disconnected from the appliance, and it was removed from the cabinetry. The smell immediately became stronger, and signs of electrical arcing were present. The area was checked for any signs of heat extension resulting from the faulty equipment. No additional hazards were found. The homeowner was advised to have the appliance repaired or replaced before restoring power to it. All units cleared from the scene and returned to service.
- 04/07/2022 Battalion Chief Eagle, Engineer Russo, and Firefighter Luciano assisted the Mount Pleasant Fire Department with returning a juvenile bald eagle back into its nest. Isle of Palms was asked to provide our aerial platform in order to complete the task in the safest manner. Tower 1002 cleared from the assignment and returned to service.
- 04/15/2022 Battalion Chief Giddens, Engineer Schwartz, and Firefighter Hogan and Sisk made a public appearance at the Isle of Palms Recreation Center for the Spring Break Soccer Camp participants. General fire education topics were discussed, and tours of the fire truck were given. Truck 1001 cleared from the assignment and returned to service.

NOTABLE EVENTS / CALL HIGHLIGHTS

- 04/16/2022 Battalion Chief Eagle; Captain Fassos; Engineers Puckhaber and Schwartz; and Firefighters Dmitriyev, Hermosillo, Sisk, and Wheat assisted with the Isle of Palms Easter Brunch at the Recreation Center.
- 04/26/2022 Fire crews responded to a surf rescue at 40th Avenue and Public Beach Access. The description of the call provided by dispatch was that a woman was being swept out in the ocean. While responding, personnel were notified that someone was swimming out to help the victim back to shore. Upon arrival all persons had made it back to shore. It was explained that the victim had gotten caught in a rip current. The victim was evaluated by Charleston County EMS. All units cleared from the scene and returned to service.
- 04/26/2022 Chief Oliverius was formally sworn in and pinned as the Fire Chief of the City of Isle of Palms at the April Council meeting.
- 04/30/2022 Fire crews responded to a patient in full arrest on Charleston Boulevard. Upon arrival, the patient was found not breathing, and without a pulse. CPR was performed by Isle of Palms Fire personnel with the assistance of Isle of Palms Police personnel. The patient fully regained both pulse and the ability to breathe. The patient was transferred to Charleston County EMS. All units cleared from the scene and returned back to service.

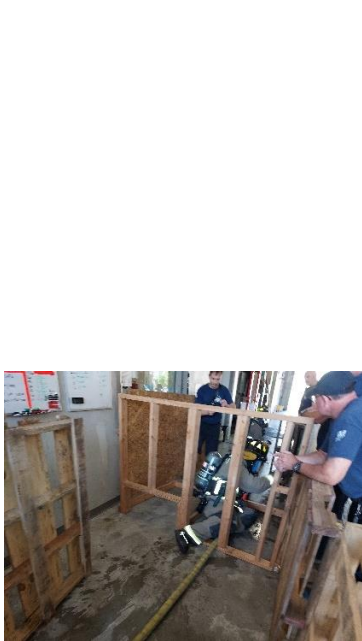

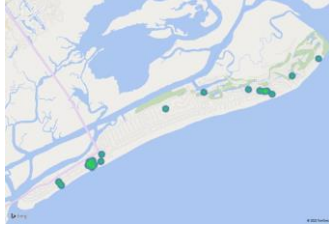

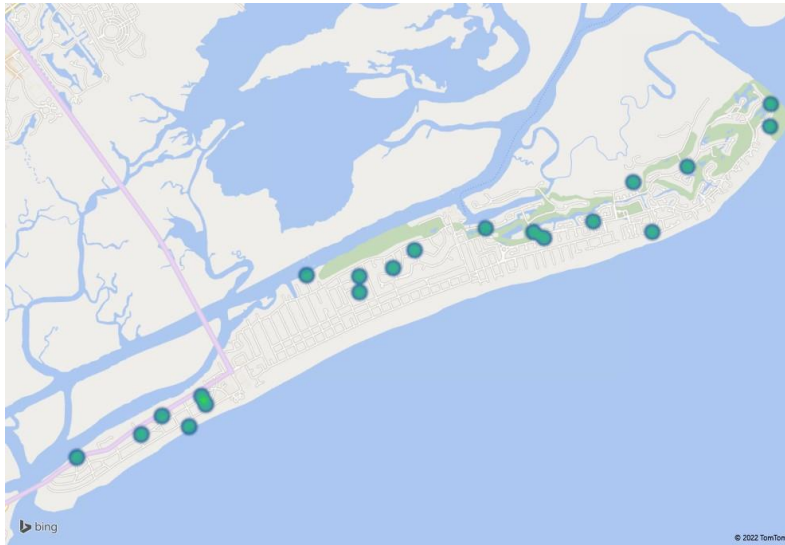
