- Pickleball Lighting: meeting with the MUSCO representative for lights at the Pickleball courts in mid January


#### **Maintenance & Repairs**

Total registrations for November - December 2023 = 597




## **Monthly Revenues 2023**

Revenue sales brought in by programs, athletics and events.


RecTrac: in-house vs WebTrac: online

November = \$16,275 December = \$15,904




## **Annual Comparison**



## **Open Gym Daily Average Visits**


Participants utilizing the gymnasium for open play
